What's your style?
Acts 17

Kenn spoke about three 'styles' of sharing Christ with not-yet-believers.

The Intellectual Style - Paul Reasoning with the philosophers & Stoics in the debating chambers & with the Jews in the Synagogues.

- Why do you think Paul chose to reason with them?

The Confrontational Style.

Acts 2 (Pentecost morning) - Peter calls for repentance from a Jewish audience. A full on full frontal presentation of the Gospel.

- Why do you think Peter chose this style of witnessing for this audience?

The Story sharing style. - someone experiences a dynamic salvation and looks for ways to tell others about it. It is not confrontational nor reasoning but simply a sharing of their story.

- **John 9:25** - I was blind now I can see.

Kenn said "Share what you **know** about Jesus, not what you don't."
