(Lost, Seek, Celebrate)

Luke 15

Read the 3 parable stories in Luke 15.

- What do the 3 stories have in common?
- What is the significance of this?

In the Session video clip, Kenn said that within each of us, lurks a secret (or not so secret) value list of which people are acceptable and which are not.

- Are there individuals or groups that you have a resentment towards?
- What are you doing in your life to be actively inclusive of all people and to show them how how much they matter to God?

In each of the stories, something or someone is missing.

- How does God feel about people who are lost and don't know His love?
- How does that impact the way you relate to lost people?

In each of the stories, there was an 'all out search' to recover that which was lost.

- Who do you know that is lost and does not know the love of Jesus?
- How do you feel when you understand that the Angels and God Himself rejoices and celebrates when a sinner is saved? (* see Matthew 15:10)

Why not, as a group, hold a Matthew Party (* see Luke 5:29) and invite your 'not-yet-saved' friends to an event or social gathering?

Take time as a group to pray together for lost family members, friends and neighbours. Don't forget to pray for each other for boldness in sharing Jesus
