Thinking Like Jesus

1 Corinthians 12:8-10

Kenn spoke about dividing the gifts of the Holy Spirit into 3 distinct categories -

1. Revelation Gifts - Thinking like Jesus.
2. Verbal Gifts - Talking like Jesus.
3. Power Gifts - Acting like Jesus.

How does this impact the way you look at spiritual gifts?

The connection between the Gospels and the book of Acts is the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Have you experience the baptism of the Holy Spirit?

- Share with the group what happened?
- How has this affected your life and journey with Jesus?

The 3 Revelation gifts provide us with supernatural insight into the past, present and future of the natural realm and also into the supernatural realm.

1. Word of Wisdom

This is a supernatural understanding to grasp the divine purposes and plans in the mind and will of God.

Examples:

- Acts 9:10-16 - Note the direction and explanation.
- Acts 15:28 - Note the Spiritual understanding.
- Acts 11:28 - Note the warning.

2. Word of Knowledge.

this is a revelation of Gods plan and a deeper and more advanced understanding of Gods acts.

Examples:

- Acts 9:11 - Ananias is told where Saul is praying.
- Acts 5:3 - Peter confronts Ananias (a different Ananias).

3. The Discerning of Spirits.

This is the supernatural power to detect the realm of spirits and their activities. It brings spiritual insight and revelation of the plans and purposes of the enemy and his forces.

Examples:

- Acts 16:16-18 - Paul casts out a demon.
- 1 Timothy 4:1 - The doctrines of demons.
- 2 Kings 6:17 - The opening of spiritual eyes.
