## Evangelism Part 1 of 6

Matthew 5:13-16

“You are the salt of the earth. But what good is salt if it has lost its flavour? Can you make it salty again?

It will be thrown out and trampled underfoot as worthless. “You are the light of the world - like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp and then puts it under a basket. Instead, a lamp is placed on a stand, where it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father.

Kenn mentioned the 3 typical responses to evangelism.

1. Excitement 2. Avoidance 3. Fear.

Which of these is yours?

Why do you think that is?

What parallels do you see between both salt and light and your role as an evangelist in the world?

How are you to be like light? How are you to be like salt?

Kenn mentioned that Jesus saved His command to evangelise and make disciples until the end.

Do you struggle with this command or is it easy to obey?

Read Acts 1:8

Jesus said that “YOU WILL BE” (not might be) His witnesses.

Witnessing is intentional.

What holds us back?

Kenn spoke of the difference between making converts and making disciples.

When people reject the Gospel, how do you feel?

Are we more interested in getting people to ‘say the words of a salvation prayer’ or in introducing them to Jesus.

Kenn spoke about ‘Belong, Believe, Behave’

Is this different to your understanding of Church?
